**Patrick F. Sullivan

Mr. Sullivan has over thirty years experience in federal law enforcement.

He was appointed to the Federal Air Marshal Service (FAMS) on July 14, 2002 and currently has oversight of the FAMS' Systems Operations Control Division, Liaison Division, and Investigations Division (which includes the Intelligence Branch, Tactical Information Branch, Investigations Branch and JTTF program). He holds a Top Secret clearance with SCI endorsements. Prior to his current appointment, Mr. Sullivan served for 3½ years as an Assistant Director with GAO's Office of Special Investigations where he supervised and participated in sensitive investigations and undercover operations requested by the Senate and House of Representatives. He has testified numerous times before Congressional committees and subcommittees.

From 1976 – 1999, Mr. Sullivan served as a Special Agent with the United States Secret Service, where he received significant investigative, protective, administrative and supervisory experience. Headquarters assignments included Deputy Special Agent in Charge – Counterfeit Division and Assistant Special Agent In Charge – Office of Government Liaison and Public Affairs. Protection assignments included ASAIC – Candidate Nominee Protection Division (where he coordinated security for the 1996 Democratic National Convention and the 1996 Presidential and Vice Presidential Debates) and four years as an agent and shift whip on the Presidential Protection Division. Field assignments included Washington Field Office (WFO) (two rotations, once as a group leader and then as the ASAIC), Seattle, New York Field Office (NYFO) and Baltimore. In addition, while assigned to WFO, Mr. Sullivan was cross-designated with Title 21, drug enforcement authority, by DEA. While assigned to NYFO, he was appointed an Organized Crime Strike Force Representative and detailed to the Department of Justice Strike Force in Brooklyn, NY.

Mr. Sullivan has additional experience as an Investigative Assistant with the Federal Bureau of Investigation, where he was assigned to the surveillance of suspected foreign intelligence officers attached to the United Nations and Soviet Consulate in New York.

During the course of his career, he has worked with state and local police agencies in forty-nine states and over thirty foreign nations. Mr. Sullivan is a graduate of Xavier High School and the John Jay College of Criminal Justice in New York City.
